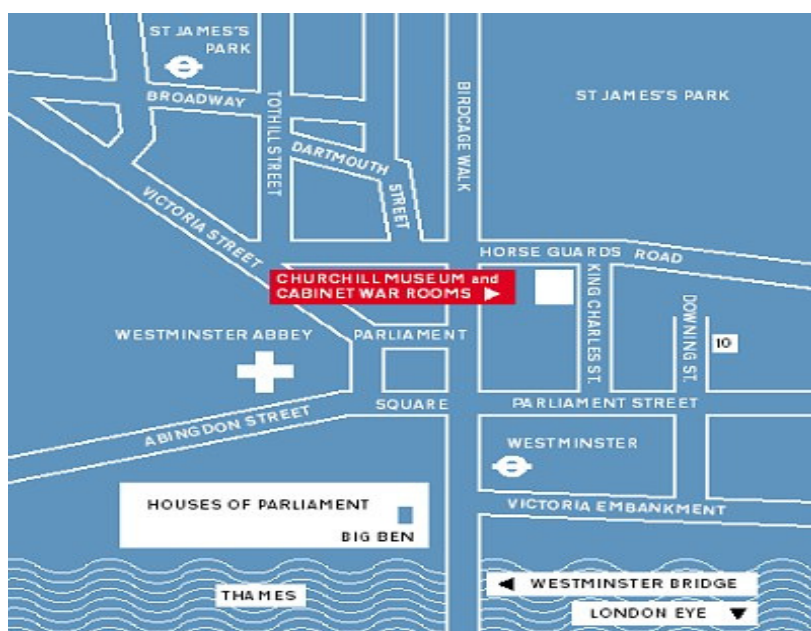
The Big Launch
